Report on SSIP 2.0 Sensitization Program

The SSIP Cell of Government Engineering College, Patan organized an SSIP 2.0

Sensitization Program exclusively for the students of the Civil Engineering Department on

7th August 2025. The primary aim of this initiative was to create awareness about the

Student Startup and Innovation Policy (SSIP) 2.0 and to motivate students to develop

innovative solutions to real-world problems through PoC (Proof of Concept) and IPR

(Intellectual Property Rights) frameworks.

The session was conducted by **Dr. Hitesh Panchal**, SSIP Coordinator of GEC Patan, who

has been actively guiding and mentoring student innovators under the SSIP initiative. The

event commenced at 11:00 am and continued till 12:15 pm, during which more than 71

students from the Civil Engineering department enthusiastically participated.

Dr. Panchal delivered an insightful session, beginning with a brief history and evolution of

SSIP 1.0 and its successful transition into SSIP 2.0, which has a broader scope, increased

funding support, and an enhanced focus on pre-incubation, IP generation, and prototype

development. He emphasized the importance of innovation and creativity in engineering

education, highlighting how SSIP empowers students with the opportunity to convert

their ideas into working prototypes and patentable products.

The session covered the following key areas:

• Overview of SSIP 2.0 and its key objectives.

Eligibility criteria for student participation and idea submission.

Step-by-step guidance on preparing and presenting a Proof of Concept (PoC).

- Importance of design thinking, problem identification, and user-centric innovation.
- Insights on IPR processes, including patent filing, copyright, and design registration.
- Showcasing success stories of previous SSIP-supported projects from GEC
 Patan and other institutions.
- Discussion on **funding support** structure under SSIP 2.0 and the role of mentors.

He also motivated students to take part in the upcoming PoC Presentation and Idea Competition events, assuring full support from the SSIP Cell for mentoring, documentation, and financial disbursement.

The session was interactive, with students raising pertinent queries about their ideas, funding procedures, timelines for PoC approval, and how to build teams. Dr. Panchal responded to each question with detailed explanations and encouraged students to think beyond traditional academic boundaries.

The program concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by the Dr M I Balya, who appreciated Dr. Panchal's efforts and encouraged the students to actively participate in SSIP activities. The session was highly impactful and served its purpose of sensitizing young innovators toward structured innovation practices.

Overall, the event was a significant step in strengthening the innovation ecosystem at GEC Patan and aligning student efforts with the goals of SSIP 2.0. It laid the foundation for increased participation from the Electrical Engineering students in future innovation and startup initiatives.
