

Report on Awareness of MOOC Sensitization and Registration

Government Engineering College, Patan organized an **Awareness Program on MOOC Sensitization and Registration** to create awareness among students about **Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs)** offered by **Gujarat Technological University (GTU)** through **SWAYAM/NPTEL** platforms.

The main objective of this initiative was to guide students regarding the concept of MOOCs, their academic and career importance, and the registration procedure. The sessions aimed to motivate students to enroll in MOOCs as recommended by GTU and to avoid common mistakes during registration.
