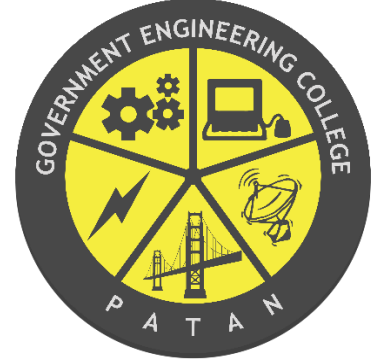

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DAY 1

The day began with registration and boarding at 6:30 a.m. at Somnath University's Guest House, followed by the official session at 10:00 a.m. under the guidance of **Manoj Shukla Sir (Senior GTU Advisor)**, **Dr. Aakash Gohil Sir (GTU Sports Officer)**, and **Chilka Jain Ma'am (GTU NSS/Cultural Advisor)**.
