






# INSTITUTE GLIMPSES

# [5] Teacher's day celebration on 5th September 2023




#### 18th September to 19th September,2023


#### 21st September, 2023

At 2:00 p.m. we had our first lecture on Rock Formation and Terminology, and after lecture we had our Fallin time at 4:00 p.m. We went to Choti Chipar for night tracking. First we went to Saint Mandir, and from their we went to Choti Chipar, it had a beautiful view point from where we can have wonderful view of Girnar. At 6:30 p.m. we went in the forest and started our tracking in night. It was very adventurous and also risky because we can't saw anything there, we are just following the steps of the person who is infront of us. And then at around 8:00-8:15 p.m. we reached the center and had our dinner. At night we had our assembly session. Then we all went to barrack.

Then, after that for evening session we went for Long-Sling Rappelling at rock no:14. On 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2023 during morning session we went to CrackClimbing on rock no:31 and Long-Sling Rappelling on rock no:30 and then we had our lecture on Rappelling and Belaying. On 24thSeptember, 2023 during morning session we went for Stomach Rappelling on rock no:21 and for evening session due to rain we didn't went to field but at 6:00 p.m. Instructor called us and gave the work of cutting the grass and clean the center area. Then at night we had our assembly session and some students had shown drama, dance and also some had sung the song. Then our D.O.(Duty Officer) for the next day had been selected and NSS clap for previous D.O. had been done.











# 25thSeptember to 26<sup>Th</sup> September, 2023 (Whole Day Tracking, Chimney climbing)

Today, we wake up at early morning for the preparation of whole day track. So, in early morning the girls who know cooking went to kitchen to help the people here. For evening session we went for long-sling rappelling and stomach rappelling but as soon as we went there rainfall started, so we went to the cave for protecting our self from the rain. After rain stop we climb down and went to center.



# 27thSeptember, 2023 (Exam Day, Closing Ceremony)

Finally after the hard work of 9 days, now it was the last day of our training. Today, our instructor were going to took our test of climbing and rappelling and about knot. First test was taken by Pradeep sir, it was theorotical test and they asked us few question and gave the task of tying the knot with the help of sling.
