Voluntary blood donors are the cornerstone of a safe and adequate supply of blood and blood products. The purpose of the blood donation camp is to select a suitable donor whose blood is safe to the recipients and who himself shall not in any way be harmed by blood donation. The number of voluntary blood donors increased from 54.4% in 2006–2007 to 83.1% in 2011–2012, with the number of blood units increasing from 4.4 million units in 2006–2007 to 9.3 million units in 2012–2013. 12.7 million units were donated in 2020, lower than projected due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Event "Mega Blood Donation Camp" is organized on 27th March, at Primary School of Adiya by N.S.S GEC Patan Unit. This event was Organized in the Special Camp of Adiya Village. We arranged the rally with the slogans in the Adiya village to aware the people about the donation of blood. Then after the rally in the event, we invited the team of the Red Cross Society to collect the blood from the donor and save that blood for a future emergency. First of all, the volunteers prepared a room for blood donation Then Our program officer Miss. Payal Prajapati Ma'am starts the donation of blood.
